## Did You Know?

**In Maths (Decimals & Place Value)**, most exam slips happen when students forget that “moving a digit one place” changes its value tenfold. For example,  $3.4 \times 10 = 34$ , but  $3.4 \div 10 = 0.34$ . Examiners often hide this trick inside multi-step problems, especially money or measurement ones. Practising quick place-value shifts daily builds automatic accuracy — a huge timesaver in long calculations.

## Did You Know?

**In Non-Verbal Reasoning (Reflection & Symmetry)**, your eyes can trick you when shapes are shaded. Examiners use diagonal reflections and mirror flips to test precision. A quick hack: cover half the figure with your finger and imagine folding it — if both sides wouldn't overlap perfectly, it's not symmetrical. Practising mirrored drawing for 5 minutes a week builds incredible spatial accuracy.
